

John 1:35-51

- I. Two disciples of John the Baptist. John 1:35-42
 - A. John told his two disciples that Jesus is the Lamb of God. John 1:35-36
 - B. The two disciples started following Jesus. John 1:37
 - C. Jesus asked them what they wanted. John 1:38
 - 1. They called Jesus Rabbi -Master. John 1:38
 - a. They confessed Jesus as the Christ. Matthew 23:7-8
 - 2. They wanted to know where Jesus would dwell. John 1:38
 - a. Jesus said Come and see. John 1:39
 - 3. They saw where Jesus dwelt. John 1:39
 - a. A city or place was not identified.
 - b. Jesus by the Holy Spirit would dwell in them. 1 Corinthians 6:19, 2 Corinthians 6:16, Ephesians 3:17, Revelation 3:20
 - D. One of John the Baptist disciple, Andrew, found his brother Simon. John 1:40
 - 1. Andrew testified that Jesus is the Messiah, the Christ. John 1:41
 - 2. Andrew brought Simon to Jesus. John 1:42
 - E. Jesus knew Simon's name and his father's name, because He is God.

- F. Simon was named Cephas (Syrian word meaning a small stone) (Peter is a Greek word meaning a small stone) by Jesus.

 John 1:42
 - 1. Peter's statement about Jesus would be the rock foundation for Christ's church. Matthew 16:17-18
- II. Jesus goes to Galilee and finds Philip. John 1:43-44
 - A. Philip finds Nathanael. John 1:45
 - 1. Philip testifies that Jesus of Nazareth is the one prophesied. John 1:45
 - 2. Nathanael has doubts about Jesus. John 1:46
 - B. Jesus reveals that he knows Nathanael. John 1:47
 - 1. Nathanael would like to know how Jesus knew him. John 1:48
 - 2. Jesus as God saw Nathanael under the fig tree before Philip saw him. John 1:48
 - 3. Nathanael confessed Jesus as the Son of God. John 1:49
 - 4. Nathanael will see greater things by faith. John 1:50-51
