1 Corinthians 16:1-4**

**1 Corinthians 16:1 "Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye."**

**Notes****Romans 15:26**

“For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem.”

**2 Corinthians 8:1**

“Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia;”

**2 Corinthians 8:2**

“How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality.

**Notes****2 Corinthians 8:4**

“Praying us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and *take upon us* the fellowship of the ministering to the saints.”

**2 Corinthians 8:5**

“And *this they did*, not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God.”

**2 Corinthians 9:9**

“(As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever.”

**“Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for *your* food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;)”**

**“Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God.”**

**Notes****1 Corinthians 16:2**

**“Upon the first *day* of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as *God* hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.”**

**17****Leviticus 23:10**

**“Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:”**

**18****Leviticus 23:11**

**“And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.”**

**Q8. The Feast of Firstfruits is on the morrow \_\_\_\_\_ the sabbath which is the \_\_\_\_\_ day of the week.**

**Notes****Malachi 3:9**

**“Ye *are* cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, *even* this whole nation.”**

**20****Malachi 3:10**

**“Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that *there shall not be room enough to receive it.*”**

**Q9. When you \_\_\_\_\_, you will open the windows of heaven to receive a blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.**

**21****1 Corinthians 15:22**

**“For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.**

**23 But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ’s at his coming.”**

4 And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments:”

### Luke 24:5

“And as they were afraid, and bowed down *their* faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead?

6 He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee,”

“Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.”
