1 Corinthians 5:6 “Your glorying *is* not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?”

Q1. How much leaven will leaven the whole church, a lot or a little? \_\_\_\_\_

1 Corinthians 5:7 “Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:”

Q2. The local church is to purge out the \_\_\_\_\_ leaven.

Q3. The local church is to be \_\_\_\_\_.

Q4. Christ, our \_\_\_\_\_ is sacrificed for us.

Leviticus 23:4 “These *are* the feasts of the LORD, *even* holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.

5 In the fourteenth *day* of the first month at even *is* the LORD’S passover.”

Q5. The Passover is on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of the first month.

Leviticus 23:6 “And on the fifteenth day of the same month *is* the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

7 In the first day ye shall have an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.

8 But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: in the seventh day *is* an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work *therein*.”

Q6. The feast of Unleavened Bread is on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of the first month.

Q7. The holy convocation, the high sabbath, is on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of the first month and the following \_\_\_\_\_ day.

Leviticus 23:9 “And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,  
10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:

11 And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.”

Q8. The feast of the Firstfruits is on the first day \_\_\_\_\_ the regular sabbath.

Leviticus 23:15 “And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

16 Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

21 And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, *that* it may be an holy convocation unto you: ye shall do no servile work *therein*: *it shall be* a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations.”

Q9. The feast of Pentecost is \_\_\_\_ days after the feast of Firstfruits with a holy convocation, the high sabbath.

Leviticus 23:23 “And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first *day* of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

25 Ye shall do no servile work *therein*: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.”

Q10. The feast of Trumpets is on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of the seventh month with a holy convocation, the high sabbath.

Leviticus 23:26 “And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

27 Also on the tenth *day* of this seventh month *there shall be* a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

**28 And ye shall do no work in that same day: for it is a day of atonement, to make an atonement for you before the LORD your God.**

**32 It shall be unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth day of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.”**

**Q11. The feast of Atonement is on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of the seventh month, with a holy convocation, the high sabbath.**

**Leviticus 23:33 “And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,**

**34 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto the LORD.”**

**Q12. The feast of Tabernacles is on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of the seventh month.**

**Leviticus 23:35 “On the first day shall be an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.**

**36 Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it is a solemn assembly; and ye shall do no servile work therein.”**

**Q13. The holy convocation, the high sabbath, is on the first day and eighth day.**

**1 Corinthians 5:8 “Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.”**

**Q14. The local church is to keep the feast of Passover, the Lord’s Supper, not with the old leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the \_\_\_\_\_ bread of sincerity and truth.**
