Leviticus 23:6 "And on the fifteenth day of the same month *is* the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

7 In the first day ye shall have an holy <u>convocation</u>: ye shall do no servile work therein.

8 But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: in the seventh day *is* an holy <u>convocation</u>: ye shall do no servile work *therein*."

- Q6. The feast of Unleavened Bread is on the _____ day of the first month.
- Q7. The holy convocation, the high sabbath, is on the _____ day of the first month and the following _____ day.

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Leviticus 23:9 "And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:

11 And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it."

Q8. The feast of the Firstfruits is on the first day _____ the regular sabbath.

Leviticus 23:15 "And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

16 Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

21 And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, *that* it may be an holy <u>convocation</u> unto you: ye shall do no servile work *therein: it shall be* a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations."

Q9. The feast of Pentecost is <u>days</u> days after the feast of Firstfruits with a holy convocation, the high sabbath.

Leviticus 23:23 "And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first *day* of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy <u>convocation</u>.

25 Ye shall do no servile work *therein*: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD."

Q10. The feast of Trumpets is on the <u>day of the seventh month with a</u> holy convocation, the high sabbath.

Leviticus 23:26 "And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 27 Also on the tenth *day* of this seventh month *there shall be* a day of atonement: it shall be an holy <u>convocation</u> unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD. 28 And ye shall do no work in that same day: for it *is* a day of atonement, to make an atonement for you before the LORD your God.
32 It *shall be* unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth *day* of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath."

Q11. The feast of Atonement is on the _____ day of the seventh month, with a holy convocation, the high sabbath.

Leviticus 23:33 "And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 34 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month *shall be* the feast of tabernacles *for* seven days unto the LORD."

Q12. The feast of Tabernacles is on the _____ day of the seventh month.

Leviticus 23:35 "On the first day *shall be* an holy <u>convocation</u>: ye shall do no servile work *therein*.

36 Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an holy <u>convocation</u> unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it *is* a solemn assembly; *and* ye shall do no servile work *therein*."

Q13. The holy convocation, the high sabbath, is on the <u>first</u> day and <u>eighth</u> day.

1 Corinthians 5:8 "Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened *bread* of sincerity and truth."

Q14. The local church is to keep the feast of Passover, the Lord's Supper, not with the old leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the ______ bread of sincerity and truth.
