- I. Appointed unto men once to die. Hebrews 9:27
- II. This verse does not mention an appointed time, but just that men are appointed to die. Hebrews 9:27
- III. To die does not mean to cease to exist. Hebrews 9:27
- IV. When is a person dead? Genesis 35:18
- V. The creation of a human. Psalm 139:14-16
- VI. Then it is appointed unto men once to die. Hebrews 9:27
- VII. "But after this the judgment." Hebrews 9:27
 - A. A person does not go to Hell or Heaven because of their works. John 3:18
 - B. Since they are already in Hell or Heaven, why a judgment after death?
 - C. There are two judgments after death.
 - 1. One for the saved.
 - 2. One for the lost.
 - D. Only the saved will be judged at the Judgment Seat of Christ.
 - 1. This judgment will be after the Rapture in Heaven.
 - a. The air is Satan's headquarters. Ephesians 2:2
 - b. The war in Heaven, Michael is to cast Satan out, but needs help. Revelation 12:7-13
 - c. A special army is called to cast out Satan. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

- 2. When Satan is cast out of Heaven, this starts the 7 years tribulation on the earth. Matthew 24:21
- 3. The Judgment Seat of Christ starts after Satan is cast out of Heaven. 2 Corinthians 5:10, 2 Timothy 4:1, Matthew 16:27
- 4. This judgment is not for salvation, but for rewards. 1 Corinthians 3:10-13
 - a. The fire is symbolic of the Holy Spirit. Matthew 3:11
 - b. The results of this judgment. 1 Corinthians 3:14-15
- E. Only the lost will be judged at the Great White Throne Judgment.
 - 1. This judgment will be at the end of the World. Revelation 20:11
 - a. Satan will be loosed out of the bottomless pit. Revelation 20:7-10
 - b. The Great White Throne Judgment is set up and the world is destroyed. Revelation 20:11
 - c. The lost are raised from the graves and judged according to their works. Revelation 20:12-13
- d. The results of this judgment are the different punishments in Hell.
