



John 2:12-25 Seven Feasts of the Lord

 - 2. Feast of Unleavened Bread Symbolic of the Burial of Christ. Leviticus 23:6
 - 3. Feast of the Firstfruits Symbolic of the Resurrection of Christ. Leviticus 23:10
 - 4. Feast of Pentecost Symbolic of the Power of the Holy Spirit. Leviticus 23:16



- 5. Feast of Trumpets Symbolic of the Rapture. Leviticus 23:24
- 6. Feast of Atonement Symbolic of the Tribulation Period. Leviticus 23:27
- 7. Feast of Tabernacles Symbolic of 1,000 years reign of Christ. Leviticus 23:34

 - 2. Jesus stops the selling and money changing. John 2:15-16
 - 3. Jesus fulfills Psalm 69:9. John 2:17
