- I. Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship. Matthew 14:22-23
- II. Jesus went into a mountain to pray alone. John 6:15
  - A. His disciples went down unto the sea. John 6:16
  - B. They entered into a ship. John 6:17
    - 1. They rowed the ship toward Capernaum. John 6:17
    - 2. It was dark and Jesus was not with them. John 6:17
    - 3. A great wind blew upon the sea. John 6:18, Matthew 14:24
    - 4. They had rowed about three or four miles in the storm. John 6:19
    - 5. They saw Jesus walking on the water toward them around three AM. John 6:19, Matthew 14:25
    - 6. They were afraid. John 6:19, Matthew 14:26
    - 7. Jesus said, "It is I, be not afraid." John 6:20
      - a. Elisha told his servant to fear not. 2 Kings 6:15-17
      - b. Fear not for I have redeemed thee. Isaiah 43:1-2
      - c. Fear not you are of more value. Luke 12:7
      - d. In persecution be not afraid. Acts 18:9, 1 Peter 3:14

  - a. Will you receive Jesus? Revelation. 3:20
  - b. Immediately the ship was at the land. John 6:21
- III. In the morning the people were waiting for Jesus to return from praying in the mountain. John 6:22-23
  - A. When they saw that Jesus was not there.
    - 1. They knew that Jesus did not leave with the disciples by ship. John 6:22-23
    - 2. They went to Capernaum by ship. John 6:24
- IV. They found Jesus in Capernaum. John 6:25
  - A. They asked Jesus how he got to Capernaum without a ship. John 6:25
    - 1. Jesus told them why they were seeking him. John 6:26-27, Ezekiel 33:30-33
