

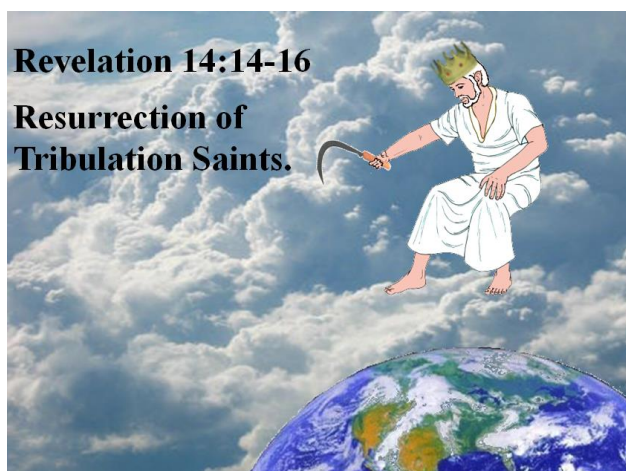


Revelation Lesson 36

Two Harvest
